

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

FUNNEL CAN BE ADJUSTED TO HEIGHT REQUIRED AND IS HELD IN POSITION BY THE THUMB SCREW.

GAUGE FLOAT ROD RAISES WITH LEVEL OF OIL AND INDICATES WHEN DRUM IS FULL.

TO CHANGE WASTE OIL DRUM

- 1. Loosen the two LATCH KNOBS at the BASE several turns to release the SLEEVE from BASE.
- 2. Lift SLEEVE from BASE raising it high enough to clear LUBRICANT DRUM. The two INDENTED HANDLES in SLEEVE provide a convenient means of lifting the SLEEVE.
- Empty drum should then be placed centrally on the BASE.
 Avoid bumping LATCH KNOBS when placing LUBRICANT DRUM or BASE.
- 4. Replace the SLEEVE on the BASE being careful in guiding the KEY-HOLE SLOTS on to the LATCH KNOBS.
- 5. Tighten LATCH KNOBS securely so that SLEEVE is clamped firmly to the BASE.
